NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The Allen County Commissioners will receive sealed bids for the FY'07 Formula, 2008 Main Street Curbing Project in the Village of Cairo, OH.

Bids will be received at the office of the Allen County Commissioners, 301 N. Main Street, Lima, Ohio 45801, until 10:00 a.m. (local time), May 15, 2008, at which time and place bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. Bids received after 10:00 a.m. (local time) will be returned unopened.

A Unit Price bid will be considered for total construction costs. The project consists of the replacement of approximately 800 lineal feet of concrete curb and gutter, 750 square feet of concrete sidewalk, 110 SY of concrete pavement, 3 catch basins and other miscellaneous work.

Bids must be signed and submitted on the separate bidding forms included in the Bidding Documents, sealed in the provided envelope, and shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid amount or by a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful BIDDER will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid.

Attention of bidders is called to all requirements contained in this bid packet, particularly to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis-Bacon Wages, various insurance requirements, and various equal opportunity provisions.
